


Airport Mapping Database – <i>Flight Alert</i>

<i>Affected Airport</i>	KYNG
<i>Detailed Description</i>	The runway designated 143.323 in the charts is labeled as 14R.32L in the airport mapping database.
<i>Pilot Actions</i>	Be aware that the runway designated 143.323 in the AIP charts is the same runway labeled 14R.32L in the database. This runway is for military operations only .
<i>Corrective Action</i>	No change will be made to the airport mapping database until the runway in consideration is provided a name within the current standards. The current runway designation conflicts with the runway naming standard: AC 150/5340-1L. This flight alert will stand until the runway name is changed to be compliant with these standards.
<i>Anticipated Correction Cycle</i>	TBD*
