

COURSE TITLE: Electronic Checklist Management Tool (ECMT) ILT

PREREQUISITES:

Students should have basic knowledge of aircraft checklist creation and modification procedures and requirements. Each user must have a Rockwell Collins Alliance account and equivalent CASE CM account.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this course is to provide airline operators and aircraft owners with training to use the ECMT software to create and modify checklist files specific to their aircraft.

OBJECTIVES: Upon completing this course, the student should be able to:

1. Access ECMT
2. Create a checklist
3. Edit a checklist
4. Export a Master Report
5. Generate a Loadset
6. Identify Configuration Manager tool functions

COURSE LENGTH: 2 Days

TRAINING DEVICES:

1. ECMT is accessed through Citrix Receiver on any computer
2. A user account must be set up for each student prior to access.
3. Students shall bring a computer with network access capability.
4. Network access will be provided in the classroom
